The **Kansas Preservation Alliance** presents annual **Awards for Excellence** for **Historic Preservation Projects** to honor individuals/groups involved in the design and/or rehabilitation of historic buildings and sites across Kansas. Nominated projects must meet the **Secretary of Interior's Standards for Rehabilitation** (<http://www.cr.nps.gov/hps/tps/standguide/index.htm>) and the criteria for listing properties in the **Register of Historic Kansas Places** (<http://www.kshs.org/p/national-and-state-registers/14635>).

Historic Preservation Project Category (circle one):

- **Preservation:** Sustain the existing form, integrity, and materials of an historic property.
- **Rehabilitation:** Repair, alternations, and additions while preserving primary character-defining features.
- **Restoration:** Removal of non-period features and reconstruction of missing features from a specific era.
- **Reconstruction:** New construction of features to replicate a specific period.
